

Amniotic Band Syndrome

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Abstract

Amniotic band syndrome (ABS) is a rare congenital disorder which associated with physical abnormalities such as disruption, deformation, and malformations of organs which were intended to develop normally.¹ The commonest abnormalities usually involve the limbs and can range from simple constriction rings to complete amputation occurring at various levels.^{1,2}

Early prenatal diagnosis is important to provide accurate information to the parents, predict the prognosis and in some cases perform in-utero lysis of the bands to restore the blood flow to the affected limb. A postnatal multidisciplinary approach involving vascular decompression, reconstructive surgery, prosthesis, and physiotherapy are some of the therapeutic options.^{3,4}

This case report is about a new born male baby who was normally delivered and he presented with ring-like constriction at over middle right lower limb and fusion (syndactyly) of left lower limb and right arm. This case reported the different diagnostic modalities which can be used for diagnose ABS, the risk factors, type of ABS, post natal ABS diagnose, and therapy ABS
