**Guidelines for Abstract Submission and Eligibility Criteria:**

- Young Investigators, Post-Graduate students, Post-doctoral fellows, Trainees, junior faculty with a minimum research experience
- Young Researcher Award is open to any person from any place across the world who has been involved in pediatrics, neonatology and related research activities
- Relevant to at least one of the topics under discussion at the Pediatrics Healthcare 2020. Submissions will be denied if not found related to the scope/area of the conference
- Focused on research in relevant fields neonatology, healthcare, pediatrics and its departments/subspecialties.
- The award is restricted up to the age limit of 35yrs
- Award would be given to the individuals from academic organization/ research institutes /industry
- The papers submitted will be subjected to verification for authenticity. Plagiarism shall lead to cancellation of award
- Candidates can apply for 2 conferences at most & submissions must be in English
- Abstracts should not be beyond 300 words
- Accompanied by the following information: your name, photograph, affiliation with a university or other academic institution, contact details and biography. Size of abstracts should not exceed 1 MB
- Photograph should be should not exceed 50 kb in size
- A duly signed endorsement letter by the departmental head/ faculty member. Size of letter should not exceed 1 MB
- Each applicant must make a brief power point presentation of about 30 minutes about his/her research work at the conference

- This may be followed by 10 minutes Q&A session
- Last date of nominations is April 01, 2020.

- •Young Scientist Award recognition certificate and memento to the winner
- Pediatric Healthcare 2020 provide best platform for research through oral presentation
- Young Scientists will get appropriate and timely information by this Forum
